THE PROJECT

- Would you like to know more about the personal stories of **fighters for human rights, courageous feminists** and **brave activists**?
- Are you interested in **contemporary history** and **culture of remembrance** and would like to discuss these topics with a group of young people from different countries?
- Are you a creative person or are you passionate about **art and illustration**?

Then you are the perfect candidate for this project!

“Biographies of resistance” wants to discuss the topic of underrepresentation of marginalized groups (women, religious and national minorities, LGBTQ+, refugees, and migrants) in formal education, historical narratives, and public space.

The marginalization of these groups in European remembrance suggests that they aren’t relevant and don’t deserve to be included in the narrations about our common past. In this workshop, we want to oppose this interpretation and consider the important role they had covered in 20th-century history.

Together with other young people from Croatia, Czech Republic, Italy, Greece, Serbia, and Spain, you will have the chance to discuss these topics, meet new people and learn together in an informal way. You will also have the opportunity to express your creativity and imagination in the creative workshops together with an illustrator.
