## PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The project **“Meeting Memories: Learning from the Past to Confront Dehumanization Today”** aims to include European citizens in a reflection on the politics of dehumanization and scapegoating happening during the 1930s and 1940s, and generate a reflection on similar patterns happening today. It also wants to promote a discussion on Holocaust education, and engage citizens in confronting distortions of historical facts about the suffering in concentration camps during World War II.

The **“Meeting Memories” closing event** will include the opening of two exhibitions, the first related to Nazi and Fascist concentration camps and curated by Nataša Mataušić, the second exploring the theme of memory and WWII through the use of photography and comics, selected by the artists and curators Sandra Vitaljić and Saša Kralj. During the event, the participants will have the chance to take part to a guided tour of the memorial places of the city of Udine, connected with World War Second, and encounter the two survivors of Italian concentration camps: Slavko Malnar and Marija Šimić.

The event will take place in **Udine, Italy, the 25<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup> of May.**

## COSTS

Traveling to Udine and back, accommodation, meals a day and all program activities during the event are fully covered by the organizers.

### TRAVEL COSTS

The travel costs will be reimbursed based on the cheapest and closest to the venue possibilities (second class railway tickets, bus tickets, low-cost flights), accompanied by the receipt of complete and original tickets, invoices, bills, receipts, or boarding cards.

The maximum contribution for travel costs for one person, from hometown to Ljubljana and back is the following:

For participants from other countries, please calculate your maximum contribution based on this calculator: [Distance Calculator | Erasmus+ \(europa.eu\)](#), indicating your hometown as start and Udine as end. The contribution depends on the kilometers, following this table:

Kilometers	Maximum contribution per person in Euro
0 – 99 km	23 EUR
100 – 499 km	180 EUR
500 – 1999 km	275 EUR
2000 – 2999 km	360 EUR

The project team will reimburse the tickets to the participants **after** the conclusion of the event.

## CHECK LIST FOR TRAVEL REIMBURSEMENT:

### 1. Regular plane tickets must be accompanied:

- by the **original invoice** (signed and stamped)/receipt/pay order/proof of payment
- the **boarding pass** (the small ticket with QR code you receive before boarding the plane)
- the **prices** stated in the invoices, receipts etc. must **coincide** with the price on the ticket

### 2. Electronic air tickets must be:

- **printed out** and include your **name, the exact fare you paid, details of your flight on the same page**
- provided along with **the credit card receipt for the payment or a copy of your bank statement** (clearly showing the payment has been made)
- given in with the **boarding pass** (ticket with QR code)

### NOTES:

- Some airlines print “passenger receipt” at the top of the cardboard ticket. It is not accepted as a receipt of proof of payment. Therefore, if you book your tickets online, please, make sure to print out the e-mail you receive from the airline company upon the payment, stating how much and how you paid.
- If you use an App for booking your plane, be sure to save or screenshot the boarding passes, as they disappear from the application after you have used them.

### 3. Train/Bus tickets

- It is important that that **arrival and departure time** as well as **the price** are visible (+ invoices if available)

### Other important details:

- Missing or lost tickets are not reimbursed
- Booking paper alone is not enough
- Any costs for taxi are not reimbursed
- Return tickets must be bought in advance before the journey

The travel must take place on the direct way within **maximum 2 days** from the dates of beginning and ending of the event. In case of long pauses or indirect routes (holiday travel), there is no reimbursement of travel costs.

## TRAVELING TO UDINE

We would like to welcome you all on **Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> of May at 13:00**. Please plan your travel according to this arrival time. In case of any problems or delays, please contact us.

The closest airport to Udine is the **Trieste Airport**, located around 40 km away from Udine. From the airport, you can take a train or a bus to Udine, please check the timetables at [Trieste Airport - Trieste Airport](#). You can also check flights to Venice Marco Polo, Venice Treviso, Ljubljana, and Zagreb.

You can use Kiwi (<https://www.kiwi.com/>) or Skyscanner (<https://www.skyscanner.net/>) to find the best option. From these cities, there are direct connections to Udine via bus, see FlixBus (<https://global.flixbus.com/>).

## ACCOMMODATION

## REQUIREMENTS FOR ENTERING ITALY

Consider that, regardless of the country you are traveling from, to enter Italy you need to present the **COVID-19 GREEN CERTIFICATE** or other equivalent certificate which must state one of the following conditions:

- **Completion of the primary vaccination series or booster dose** according to the vaccination plans of the countries of release with vaccines authorized by the European Medical Agency (primary series validity 9 months and booster dose without predefined limit);
- **Recovery from SARS-CoV-2 infection** (valid for 180 days from positive swab test);
- **Recovery after the administration of the first dose of vaccine or at the end of the primary vaccination series or following the administration of the relevant booster dose**;

- **Rapid antigen or molecular swab test**, respectively within 48 or 72 hours before entry into Italy.

The certification regarding the completion of the vaccination series must refer to one of the vaccines approved by the European Medicines Agency: **Pfizer-BioNtech Comirnaty, Moderna, Vaxzevria, Janssen (Johnson & Johnson), Nuvaxovid (Novavax), or to vaccines considered equivalent by the Italian legislation** (Covishield, Fiocruz, R-Covi). Covid-19 green certificates of successful vaccination are accepted in one of the following languages: Italian, English, French, Spanish or German. If submitted in another language, they must be accompanied by a sworn translation into Italian. Foreign certifications of recovery must be accompanied by a sworn translation into Italian.
